**Subject:** Application of Shri Tatyasaheb Ghatage Charitable Trust, R.R. Patil College of Homoeopathy & Hospital, Dr. Ghatage Multispecialty Hospital and P.G. Institute, Sangli Pune By Pass Road, Sangli - 416416, Maharashtra for permission with intake capacity of 50 seats in BHMS course for A.Y. 2024-25 under section 29 of NCH Act 2020 and New application for increase in seats from 50 to 100 seats in BHMS course, and application for permission in new PG course in M.D. Paediatrics with 06 seats for academic year 2024- 25- regarding

Sir,

R.R. Patil College of Homoeopathy & Hospital, Maharashtra has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 50 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2024-25. College has also applied for new application for increase in seats from 50 to 100 seats in BHMS course, and application for permission in new PG course in Paediatrics with 06 seats for academic year 2024- 25. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH has conducted Inspection on 24.07.2024 and 25.07.2024 and shortfalls have been observed. MARB has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standard requirements to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020. As per the shortfalls made by MARBH, following lacunae are to be rectified with immediate effect. College shall fulfil all functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard requirements.

- A. Consent of Affiliation:** Consent of Affiliation from University for enhancement of seats from 50 to 100 seats and for new post graduate course in Paediatrics with 06 seats has not been obtained.
- B. No Objection Certificate:** No Objection Certificate from State Govt. for new application for enhancement of seats from 50 to 100 seats and for new post graduate course in Paediatrics with 06 seats has not been obtained.
- C. Infrastructure:** Land area provided by college is 2.64 acres which is not sufficient for 100 seats college. For 100 seats, land area of 4 acres is required.

**D. Hospital Facility:**

- a) Central OPD register and department wise OPD register not correlated with Dispensing register.
- b) There was no B.P. instrument and thermometer in OPDs.
- c) No urine/stool pots, ENT set and B.P. instrument was available in IPD. No curtains in any ward.
- d) Expired medicines were kept in dispensary
- e) X-ray room was non-functioning.

**E. Laboratory Equipment's:**

- a) Anatomy Department: Mummified bodies not available.
- b) Physiology Department: Educational CD, DVD, Slides, films and audio visuals aids not available. Expired chemical reagents were available. Physiology lab was not functional.
- c) Pharmacy department: No dissecting microscope available.
- d) Pathology Department: Expired chemical reagents were available.
- e) Community Medicine Department: Refrigerator not available.

**F. Teaching Departments:** No teaching diary was available in Physiology, Pathology, Obstetrics/Gynaecology and Community Medicine.

Considering the above shortfalls, and facilities available, MARB has decided to issue conditional permission to Shri Tatyasaheb Ghatage Charitable Trust, R.R. Patil College of Homoeopathy & Hospital, Dr. Ghatage Multispecialty Hospital and P.G. Institute, Sangli Pune By Pass Road, Sangli – 416416, Maharashtra for conducting BHMS course with intake capacity of 50 seats for the academic year 2024- 25.

College has submitted the new application for increase in seats from 50 to 100 seats in BHMS course, and application for permission in new PG course in MD Paediatrics with 06 seats. MARBH has examined the new application too **and decided to issue denial of permission for increase in seats from 50 to 100 seats in BHMS course, and application for permission in new PG course in MD Paediatrics with 06 seats for academic year 2024-25 base on the above mentioned shortfalls.**

All shortfalls mentioned shall be rectified within a period of 30 days and a compliance report shall be submitted to the undersigned, failing which the conditional permission issued will be withdrawn without further notice.

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the central govt for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.


The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any



admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

If, the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) regulations 2024, 'section 14 subsection (3)' and NCH General Regulation 2023 'section 22'.
